Motion/Second to approve the April 1, 2002 minutes as written. Motion passed.

Treasurer Ken Vannice – Received a note from Federal Way requesting reimbursement for some coaching clinics held last year. Because the clinics held were not the clinic that were approved last year, Module 1 or 2, the board would have to approve payment.

Motion/Second: Fund a U6, U8 and a U10 Coaching Certification for each Association to replace the Module 1 and Module 2 clinics. Discussion: The Modules no longer exists, the U6, U8, and U10 clinic replaced the Modules. The Modules cost \$200 each costing the District \$400 per Association. The U6, U8, and U10 clinics cost \$125 each and will cost the District \$375. Motion passed.

Motion/Second: Reimburse Federal Way, up to \$400, for Coaching Certification clinics held last year. Motion passed.
